About Tu Nidito and Camp Erin: The organization began more than 20 years ago and is dedicated to the mission of creating a community of acceptance and understanding regarding children in grief. Last year Tu Nidito supported over 800 children from more than 350 families.

On October 20-22, 2017 Tu Nidito, in partnership with The Moyer Foundation, will provide a free, weekend bereavement camp (Camp Erin) for children and teens ages 6 through 17 who are grieving the death of someone close to them. Campers participate in fun, traditional camp activities combined with grief education and emotional support led by Tu Nidito professionals and specially trained volunteers. Camp Erin has over 40 locations nationwide and is the largest network of bereavement camps in the country. Tu Nidito was granted the Camp Erin partnership in 2013.
