

HTML Codes

Here are a few HTML codes that you can use when entering property or profile information into MLS.

HTML (Hypertext Markup Language) uses codes called "tags" which are placed before and after the text that you wish to format. Tags are indicated with < >.

The first tag turns the property on; the second turns it off.



Bold this is my text this is my text	Italic <i>this is my text</i> <i>this is my text</i>
Underline <u> this is my text</u> <u>this is my text</u>	Color this is my text <i>blue is my text</i> (you can use most color names within the quotes)
Line Break 	Paragraph Break (2 line breaks) <p>

You can combine tags to make, for example, <i> would be ***bold italic***. Be sure to add </i> after the text.

Open a Web Page

The code shown will open a web page in a new browser window:

```

***NOTE: Using hyperlinks inside of Agent or Property Remarks is NOT allowed.
